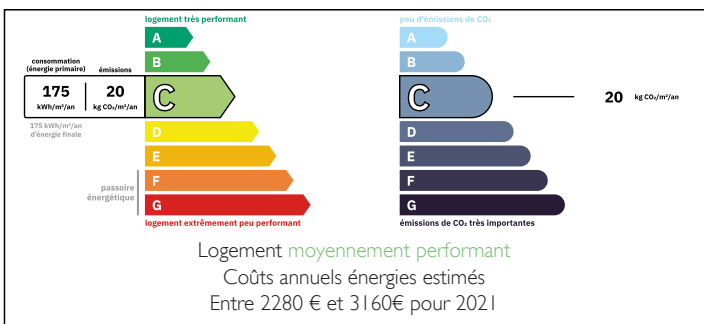

DESCRIPTION

Ground floor; fully-equipped kitchen (15m²), living room (29m²) with wood burner and stairs to the upper floors, utility room / office (8m²) with fitted cupboards, WC (1m²)

1st floor; spacious landing with fitted cupboards leading to 3 bedrooms each with en-suite shower room (comprising shower, wc and basin (21m², 17m² & 12m²))

2nd floor; bedroom 4 (12m²) with dressing room, sitting room (7m²), shower room (10m²) comprising shower, basin and wc and 2nd walk in cupboard.

This south-facing property is full of charm with exposed beams throughout, tiles on the ground floor and beautiful original oak floor boards on the two upper floors. Hot water and heating for the ground floor is via a mains gas boiler, and the bedrooms have electric heating. The second floor also benefits from air-conditioning.

This family home has been used as a bed and breakfast in the past and would be very well adapted to this.

The delightful market town is extremely popular with tourists throughout the year given its proximity to Lascaux IV, and offers a full range of pretty restaurants, shops and a bustling weekly market.
