A spacious longère, meticulously renovated by the current owners over the past 20 years from the roof down.



DESCRIPTION

Directly accessible from the road a strip of land leads to a covered parking area (50m²) perfect for parking 3 cars, complete with a shed at the end (9m²) perfect for keeping all your car maintenance equipment. To enter the main enclosed area of the property, you can either walk behind this building to a small pedestrian gate, or you can go back to the big gates a little further along the road.

Once inside the enclosed garden, the house sits to the right. Red and white roses grow up the front, giving a pretty country cottage look, and beautiful stonework including a stunning series of windows on the first floor, representing the four suits of a pack of cards, really make it stand out from the rest.

Ground floor: Entering the house through a small veranda, just big enough for depositing shoes and coats, etc. a door leads directly into the kitchen (25m²), featuring custom built units with a central island and black granite worktops. A wood-burning stove keeps it beautifully cosy during the colder months. From here, a staircase leads up to a mezzanine (12.5m² at floor level), currently used as a spare bedroom. Under the stairs a built-in cupboard offers welcome additional hanging space. A door to the right of the stairs opens onto a small corridor with further doors leading to the downstairs WC as well as a downstairs shower/utility room (6m²).
