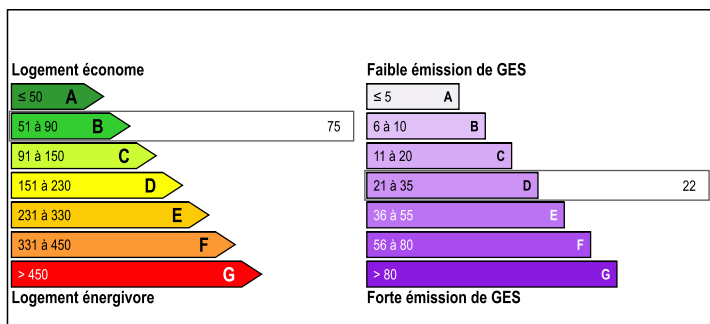

Enter into the formal reception room with a feature granite fireplace. The morning sun plays delightfully through the double glazed windows.

Also off the hallway is a guest WC and further along is the first of four generous sized bedrooms with a well-appointed bathroom hidden behind a floor to ceiling mirror.

The marvellous oak staircase leads up to the first floor which houses the newly installed kitchen and opposite on the other side of the house a very spacious lounge.

Moving on up brings us to the master bedroom with its private bathroom hidden behind a bookcase. This room has a walk-in wardrobe. Opposite is the third bedroom with another en-suite shower and WC. This bedroom has currently been dressed as a formal dining room and enjoys elevated views across the town.
