

Entering into the property you have an entrance hall that leads to the kitchen (22.2m2). Country style cabinets, farmhouse table, pellet burner and access through into a pretty veranda where you can sit and look out onto the garden and sunny terrace. At 35.8m2, the living room with dining area is ideal for entertaining and with its many original features you will feel like you have stepped back in time. Granite window trough, oak beams, central stone fireplace and arched stone window. This room was used as a wedding venue for local farmers hundreds of years ago and you can definitely see why. A downstairs WC and a utility (5.1m2) with storage space and access into the garage complete this level. To the first floor you will find the master bedroom (14.5m2) with views out over the countryside. Large walk in dressing room and ensuite shower room with WC(4.7m2) are perfect additions.
