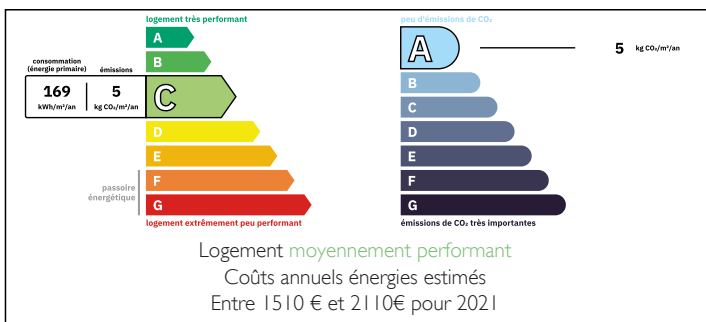

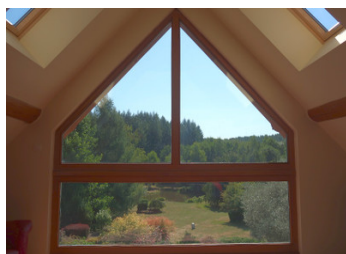
IN BRIEF

Come and see this true beauty in the middle of the Limousin hills and forests.

The house was built 17 years ago under supervision of the current owner, up to the highest standards.

You enter the property over a short dirt road at the parking between the two tool-sheds and the summer room, and the main house.

Entering the house through the front door, a small attached covered hallway opens directly into the open plan living room / dining room (57 m²) with sliding doors onto the sun terrace at the back. Attached are the kitchen (20 m²) and a comfortable lounge with a wood burner and a lot of windows overlooking the garden (36 m²).

In the heating room (7m²) you will find the water tank for the geothermal heat pump system that is connected to an under-floor central heating system that keeps the house warm during winter. Here you will find the downstairs toilet as well.

The wooden staircase takes you up to the first floor, where the landing serves as a second living room (55 m²) with a big window overlooking the garden, an office (which could be a third small bedroom) attached (6 m²), and two bedrooms (28 and 15 m²) both with a bathroom ensuite (8 and 6 m²). The main bedroom has a big sunny balcony for a cup of tea in the morning sun.
