

Enter the main house into the kitchen 29m² with stone fireplace and log burner. Stairs lead to a bedroom with en-suite bathroom 20m². Off the kitchen is an impressive living dining room 61m² with large stone fireplace and log burner, and french doors leading into the courtyard. Overlooking this delightful living area is a huge mezzanine room at 56m². Off the living room is a hallway 10.5m² with door to the outside courtyard giving easy access to the boiler room 9.5m² which doubles as a utility area. 2 further ground floor bedrooms 13 and 16m² and a shower room 6.5m² complete the main house.

The pigeonier/gite is accessed from the courtyard into an open plan kitchen diner 48m² with a shower room and separate toilet leading off.

On the first floor is an impressive sitting room 41 m² with stone fireplace, which is overlooked by the second floor mezzanine 14m².

On the third floor are 2 bedrooms 16 and $15m^2$ a hallway $7m^2$ and a bathroom $4m^2$.

There is a 10.5m² swimming pool with Roman steps within a private long garden supporting lawn and various trees and shrubs.

The large barn is 141m² of double height usable space.
