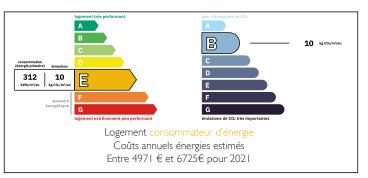

Ground Floor:

Entry hall  $(4m \times 2.6m)$ 

To the right living room with exposed stone walls and feature fireplace fitted with a wood burner  $(5.55 \times 5.4m)$ 

To the left dining room with the original stone sink preserved and fireplace fitted with a woodburner  $(8.52 \times 5.25m)$ 

Kitchen with exposed pitched roof thoughtfully designed with tons of storage space (6.00, 4.80m).

Utility room which can be locked and doubles up as a bathroom  $(4.70 \text{m} \times 2.80 \text{m})$ 

The last room on this level is q bonus space and can be used as required  $(4.90m \times 3.20m)$
