

#### DESCRIPTION

A property set on 3.0592 ha of fenced land with an electric gate opening onto a beautiful estate, on which are a Provencal farmhouse of approx. 250 m<sup>2</sup> and four furnished gîtes.

A main house with, on the ground floor: an entrance hall with toilet, a lounge/dining room, an open-plan kitchen, two storage rooms (a laundry/boiler room with oil-fired boiler), a second entrance hall with toilet, a large room used as an office and another room for a future bathroom.

A utility room equipped with the heat pump, water softener and water storage tanks is accessed via the veranda, which opens onto the kitchen.

Upstairs: a master bedroom with bathroom and toilet, two large bedrooms, a shower room and a toilet. At the end of the corridor, another flat with a large separate bedroom, a kitchen/living room, a bathroom and, upstairs, a mezzanine with several sleeping areas and a private terrace, also accessible via an outside staircase.

A second set of dwellings adjoining an old farmhouse, 4 gîtes:

First floor:

Gîte Luberon:

A spacious refurbished flat, not overlooked and completely independent with a 50 m<sup>2</sup> south-facing terrace facing the Luberon.

A lovely bright living room and American-style fitted kitchen in the foreground, then the hall with built-in cupboard leading to the two bedrooms with large wardrobes and a separate shower room and toilet.
