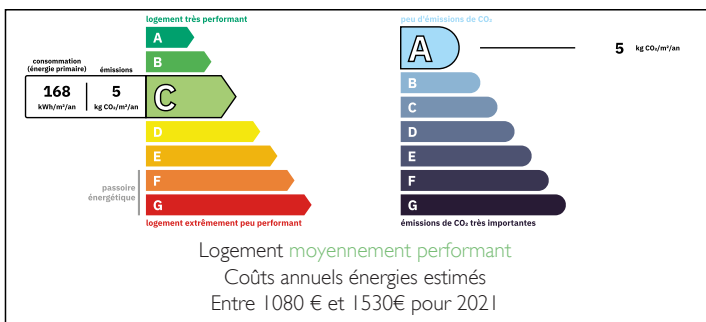

- First floor: 3 bedrooms and a bathroom with WC.

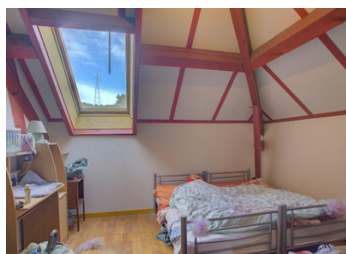
The 18,148 m² garden is fully enclosed and planted with trees.

DESCRIPTION

The fully-equipped kitchen opens onto the living room.

The many bay windows in this room open onto the covered terrace, providing plenty of natural light and a superb 180° view over the garden and swimming pool.

The ground floor bedroom (17 m²) has direct access to the garden. There is the possibility of creating a dressing room and a shower room.

A central solid oak staircase leads upstairs to the 3 bedrooms and bathroom.

The heating is a recent heat pump with underfloor heating and a wood-burning stove.

The window frames are double-glazed.

The house has its own water supply.

The access road to the house is tarmacked, landscaped and floodlit. The gate is electric with an intercom.

There are 30 productive truffle oaks, walnut, cherry and plum trees in the grounds.

Energy - C-rated house.

7 minutes from St Astier station, 27 minutes from Périgueux station, 1 hour 10 minutes from Bordeaux and 45 minutes from Brive on the A89 make this property an ideal location.
