

DESCRIPTION

This property is on an attractive street near the centre of the village. There are far reaching south facing views.

The front entrance enters into a large open plan living area (42m2) with a large brick fireplace and partially exposed brick walls. There are double windows to the front, one widow at the side and stairs leading to the first floor. The floor is neatly tiled and the electricity has been recently installed. Towards the back of this room is a small utility area with sink where there used to be a small kitchen.

Steps lead to a back room (26m2), which could make a large kitchen or additional rooms as required. There is cement flooring over the whole room and plumbing and electricity have been installed.

Wooden stairs lead to the first floor with a small landing and two bedrooms. On the right is the main bedroom (28m2) with two large windows over the front of the house and carved wooden fireplace. There is a small-integrated room with a window as well as large built-in cupboard. A set of steps lead to an extra storage area above the staircase.

The second bedroom (16m2) has a stone fireplace and original windows. There is a door from this bedroom that leads to a further room (6m2), which has a set of stairs to the attic and the boiler. There is a corridor from this room, which connects back to the landing. The attic could give scope for...
