

## DESCRIPTION

Handsome, solid stone-built house dating from the 1850s and cleverly constructed in the perfect spot to make best use of the spring water and microclimate. The views over the mountains and down the valley to the south are really breathtaking.

Ground floor: enter the spacious hallway for access to the living room and office with shower room on the right, and cosy dining room with high quality Clearview wood-burning stove, and premium Schmidt kitchen on the left. The kitchen includes a brick-built pizza oven and offers access to a small side terrace. Tiled floors throughout.

Curving staircase leads up to the first floor where the light-filled and airy hall opens to two large double bedrooms, a vestibule leading to one smaller double and storage/dressing room. From the hall also to an enormous bathroom with genuine Jacuzzi tub and generously-sized shower. Perfect for luxuriating in the welcoming ambiance. From the stair landing, a solid wooden door leads through to the long, tiled garage with room for two cars, also housing the modern gas boiler and a handy sink. Access through to garden.

The stairs continue up to the second floor where the airy hall with solid wood floorboards leads to three large double bedrooms, two of which with wash basin. The third is currently arranged as a spacious office with wood-burning stove and slim spiral staircase to a loft room. The fourth door from the hall takes us to a vestibule leading to a store room and generous...
