


In a magnificent and dramatic position, 30 km from Carcassonne, South of France. Ready for you to move in. Must enjoy mountain scenery!



DESCRIPTION

Handsome, solid stone-built house dating from the 1850s and cleverly constructed in the perfect spot to make best use of the spring water and microclimate. An ideal refuge from the heat of summer, where winters are sometimes snowy but not harsh. The views over the mountains and down the valley to the south are really breathtaking.

Ground floor: enter the spacious hallway for access to the:

Living room with fireplace, views to front and side, decorative plasterwork (30 m²)

Cosy dining room with high-quality Clearview wood-burning stove, views to front (30 m²)

Premium Schmidt kitchen includes a brick-built pizza oven and offers access to a small side terrace (24 m²).

Utility room and shower/WC (total 18 m²)

Tiled floors throughout.

Curving staircase leads up to the first floor where the light-filled and airy hall opens to two large double bedrooms with front aspect (30 m² and 28 m²),

a vestibule leads to one smaller double with wash basin, side aspect (18 m²) with storage/dressing room (3.3 m²).

From the hall to an enormous bathroom (22 m²) with genuine Jacuzzi tub and generously-sized shower. Perfect for luxuriating in the welcoming ambiance.

From the stair half-landing, a solid wooden door leads through to the long, tiled garage with room for two cars, also housing the modern gas boiler and a handy sink. Access through to garden.

The stairs continue up to the second floor where the airy hall with gleaming solid wood floors leads to three large double bedrooms (24 m², 26 m²...
