## DESCRIPTION

Charming former farmhouse dating from the late 19<sup>th</sup> century in the commune of Le Luc-en-Provence. The building has retained all the charm of that period thanks to the conservation of materials. This beautiful, sunny property comprises, on the ground floor, a spacious entrance hall, a huge, bright 60 m<sup>2</sup> living room with fireplace, a sitting room also with fireplace, fully equipped kitchen, dining area, two bedrooms, one of which is a master bedroom with shower room and WC, with built-in wardrobes, separate WC and utility room. On the first floor are three bedrooms, including a vast 29 m<sup>2</sup> master bedroom, dressing room, bathroom and separate WC. The house has reversible air conditioning.

Outside, the garden is fully fenced and gated. Numerous olive trees (which produce an interesting olive oil) and shrubs adorn the garden. The property has a swimming pool, summer kitchen, several terraces, a well and a garden shed. There is parking for several cars, a carport and a 20 m<sup>2</sup> garage/outbuilding. The 12,132 m<sup>2</sup> of land offers numerous possibilities.

The house is located on the edge of the village, in a very quiet area, just a few minutes from the village centre of Le Cannet des Maures or Le Luc-en-Provence. These villages, nestling in the Massif des Maures, are old Provencal villages that have managed to preserve their authenticity. With a dynamic local economy and significant cultural and tourist activity, it's an ideal place to spend a holiday or to live. ...
