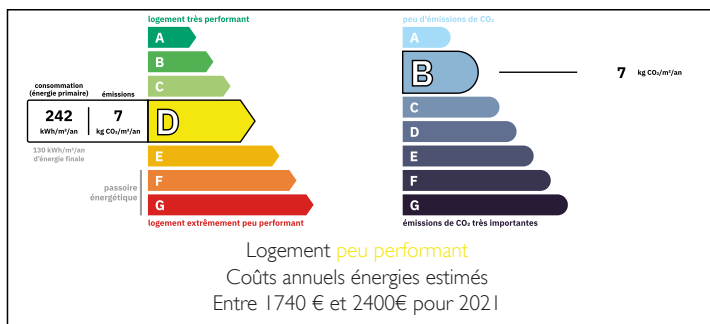

DESCRIPTION

A four storey four bedroom village house of approx. 132 m2 with a further approx 72 m2 remise and courtyard at ground level and approx 33 m2 top floor looking out over the old village.

A bright stairway leads from ground level up to a large kitchen/dining room. Directly across the hallway is a large bright front bedroom with a beautiful view of the river. At the back of the house is a slightly smaller bedroom looking out to the courtyard, and a good sized family bathroom.

A winding stairway leads to the second floor with its large living room and master bedroom both with magnificent views of the river. As well there is a further good sized bedroom and large family bathroom. Of note, there is a large storage room leading off the landing which could be converted into a good sized en-suite bathroom to the master bedroom.

Up a further staircase is the top floor which is open plan and suitable as a playroom/ guest room/ or hang out area for older kids.

A second staircase leads up to the top floor, tucked under the rafters, offering a cozy relaxation spot with large French windows and views over the rooftops of the old village.

On the ground floor, you'll find the charming coach house, once a gallery, now perfect for storing bikes or even creating an indoor beach house for enjoying the nearby natural swimming pool. It opens onto a small courtyard at the back,...
