

DESCRIPTION

This stone house comprises kitchen, living room, dining room and bathroom on the ground floor and three bedrooms (second bedroom leads on to the third bedroom) on the first floor.

The house is heated by a wood burner and has a mix of single and double glazing.

Attached to the house are a utility room and a barn in good condition. Subject to planning permission, the house could be extended to create more living area.

A small garden surrounds the building which also contains a wood shed, a small outbuilding and an old bread oven.

A short walk from the house leads to the 18 acres of prairie land. There are some existing stables housing the ponies of the current owners and a 100m2 agricultural hangar. The land is fenced and leads to a lake of around one acre where there is a mobile home situated. The land has several points of access.

Located less than one hour from Limoges airport in the heart of the Perigord National Park.
