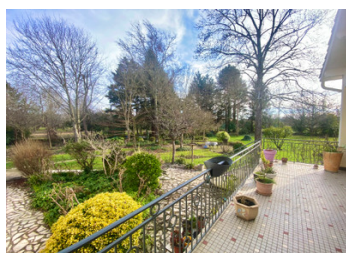
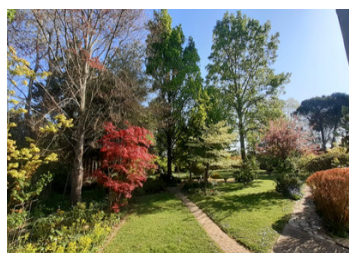

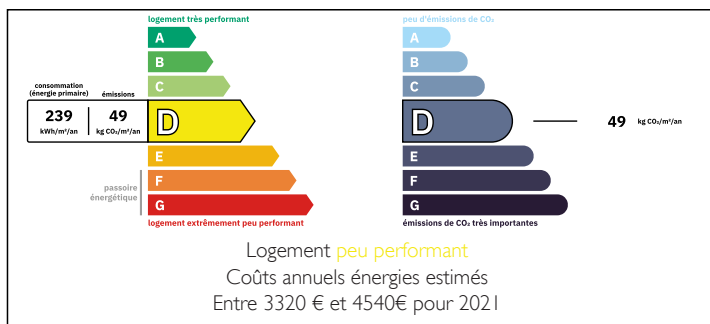
IN BRIEF

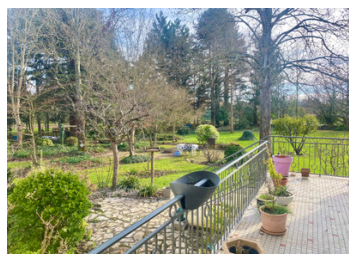
