

DESCRIPTION

The house consists of:

Front door into a hallway off of which, on the right you have the lounge with wood floor, fireplace with wood burning stove and windows to front. On the other side of the hall is the kitchen/diner with its original floor, dual aspect windows, I I/2 bowl sink and drainer, floor and wall cupboards and worksurfaces plus a large central island. There is a back door to the garden with a covered porchway leading from here also.

Upstairs there are two double bedrooms, one with walk in storage. Family bathroom with shower over, W.C and handbasin. Attic.

Outside, the mature garden, mainly laid to lawn with fruit trees and shrubs, is to 3 sides of the property. the well is also situated at the back of the house. There is a garage with storage area. Parking for two cars.

There are electric radiators throughout the house and shutters at the double glazed windows. The plumbing and electrics were re-done in 2008 and a new fosse was installed in 2007. It does conforme to regulations.

You are just 11k from the market town of Dun Le Palestel where you have all amenities, 6kms from the village of Fresselines, 30km from La Souterainne with its high speed train link direct into Paris and 84km to Limoges with its airport.
