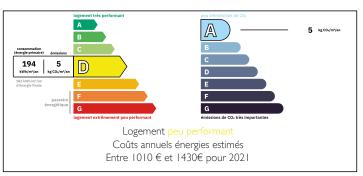

DESCRIPTION

GROUND FLOOR

The front door of the house opens up into a spacious hallway with an impressive wooden staircase leading up to the first floor and the loft space on the second floor.

The living room is through the door on your right and on the left you will find the toilet and another hallway leading to the kitchen, dining room and the pantry/utility room with access to the garden. The living room and dining room have french doors that open up to the delighful covered terrace with view of the garden.

FIRST FLOOR

The landing on the first floor leads to 3 good sized bedrooms and a bathroom. The master bedroom has an en suite shower room.

SECOND FLOOR/LOFT SPACE

From the first floor the staircase leads to a fully converted loft space with beams and slanted ceiling that can be used as an office or storage space. $(10.13m \times 1.97m)$

The property benefits from a wood-central heating system and air source heat pump installation. It also has double glazing throughout.
