DESCRIPTION

For renovation => This property is set within a peaceful countryside location and is accessed by a single track road. This ensemble of south facing stone buildings are placed around a courtyard area with 10 acres of gentle sloping pasture and long reaching countryside views to the front aspect. It would make a beautiful main residence and equally a lovely spot to create a gîte complex.

The main house requires a roof repair, there is a hole by the chimney stack which, throughout the years, has had an ingress of water and this has made the flooring on the first floor very unstable.

The adjoining barn seems to be in a dry state, the flooring does not appear to be wet. There are double large doors to the front aspect, a small door to the rear and a first floor mezzanine. It is possible to create further habitable space in the main house by opening up the dividing wall.

The detached stone barn, with double doors giving onto the courtyard, appears in a good state. There is an adjoining small building which has two rooms and would be suitable as a gîte.

A large detached hangar sits to the end of the other buildings.

To the front aspect of the main house is an old pigsty building, the roof has collapsed and requires some rebuilding of walls. There is also a well on-site.
