
IN BRIEF

DESCRIPTION

The property is accessed via a bridle path which passes behind and offers lovely country walks from the doorstep.

Entering directly into the large living room, 33.5m2 with super, large feature fireplace, housing a wood burning stove. Exposed stone work, original beams and other features abound.

Corner kitchen, 8m2, separated from the living room with open woodwork.

Bathroom with bath, basin and wc.

Upstairs there is a good size landing area and two bedrooms, 14m2 and 10m2 plus an occasional third bedroom/office 7m2

Outside there is a terrace to the front of the house and a large parking area to the side. The gardens to the front and side comprise grassed areas and woodland and offer lovely countryside views. There is a log cabin for storage.

In addition there is a large barn needing complete renovation but offering lots of possibilities.
