

Ground Floor

There is a good sized entrance with a lovely original front door, leading to the dining kitchen with fully fitted kitchen and a gorgeous stone fireplace and access out to the garden and covered terrasse.

Large and airy dining room with exposed original beams which leads to the stunning lounge with cathedral height ceiling and mezannine area. There is also a stunning stone fireplace and large picture window looking out over the garden and pool.

There are 2 good sized bedrooms on the ground floor which share a bathroom and seperate WC.

There is a gym room and dépendances/garage which could be converted into adiitional accomodation.

1st Floor

There is an office area on the mezannine overlooking the lounge. There is a storage room which could easily be converted into an additional bedroom. The master bedroom has its own balcony, walk-in wardrobe and bathroom and there is another bedroom.

There is an office area on the landing.

Outside there are 2 patios one covered, overlooking the stunning $11m \times 5m$ pool with mature gardens and a lovely view of the village of Aiguillon and ots church spire. There is a grand entrance with gates and a large driveway in front of the house.
