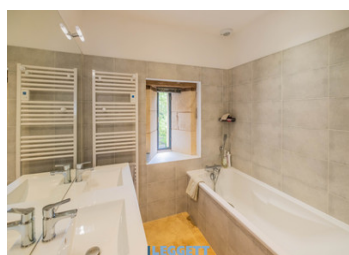
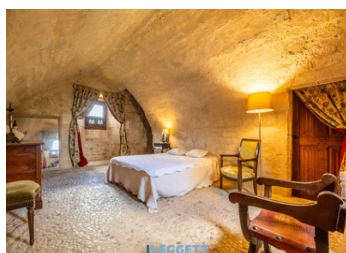

An exceptional property that has stood the test of time.

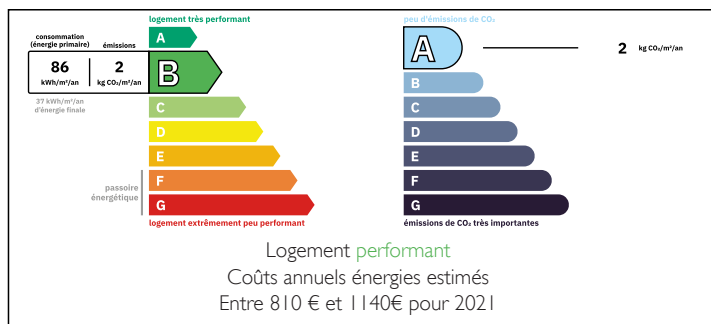
This 14th and 16th century dwelling has all the cachet and charm of homes with a soul and a history. Entirely renovated by its current owners, it is now a superb family home with elegant, warm comfort.

The materials used have been chosen with care and taste: travertine floors, solid oak flooring and staircase, superb fitted kitchen opening onto the living room with a glass roof, underfloor heating.

The property has preserved some of its historic features, such as its "demoiselle" heart-shaped floors, vaulted rooms, stone stairway, loopholes and stained glass windows, cisterns, wells and medieval cellars (listed building).

The 150 m² (1,615 sq ft) dwelling with its 3/4 bedrooms, its adjoining tower (2 bedrooms possible) and the small summer house make it a unique place to receive family and friends...

*A fully restored LODGE (XIII) with ;

Ground floor:

- Living room / Dining room / Entrance: 46 m² with open fireplace
- Fitted and equipped kitchen: 20 m².
- Storeroom: 3.7 m²
- Utility room: 4.4 m²

First floor:

- Landing: 14 m² (14 sq ft)
- Bedroom 1: 12.4 m²
- Bedroom 2: 12.7 m²
