OFFER ACCEPTED On the ground floor is a large living room with stone fireplace, perfect for a log or pellet burning stove to create that cosy ambiance. Through a doorway you arrive in what could be a nice light kitchen kitchen, with a shower/WC room beyond. French windows open onto the garden. Up the recently installed staircase you find a large attic room. The roof looks to be in good condition and has been partially insulated. A dormer window lets in light from the front. The high roof would lend itself perfectly to a statement bedroom with cathedral ceiling.

To the left of the property is an attached barn, that is itself semi-detached on one side to a neighboring cottage. This usefully large space with a second stone fireplace could perhaps be transformed into additional living space (subject to authorisation), either an enlargement of the main house or a separate dwelling.

Outside is a lovely lawned garden and some mature trees. On the opposite side of the little lane is an area of woodland, currently partly used for parking and as a lovely shaded picnic area. There are three or four other houses in the hamlet making for a friendly little community, and beyond that the hamlet is surrounded by the countryside.
