The main house has been renovated to create a one bedroomed dwelling with an open plan living space with wood burner downstairs with stairs leading to a shower room and bedroom on the 1st floor.

The attached house to renovate is larger. It has feature beams, a large stone fireplace, lovely built-in wooden cupboards. The staircase has been removed, the roof completely re-done on both sides, and insulated. There are several Velux® windows.

Situated just 2.km from the village of Clave and the large reservoir, the property layout is as follows:

Kitchen/living-room with woodburner: 24 m2

Hall: 2,7 m2

1st floor

Bedroom: 19,2 m2

Shower Room: 2,8 m2

The second house is only partly renovated.

Main Room: 28,27 m2

Smaller Room: 13,56 m2

Upstairs (no stairs)

Large room: 39,83 m2

The property benefits from a microstation sewerage system

The roof needs attention, as there are some leaks that need to be repaired, and the zinc gutter between the two houses does not go the entire length of the building as it should.

The 35 m2 garage with a large sliding door is a stone's throw from the house.

The 164 m2 garden un attached is full of trees and bushes, and needs an entrance cut through the high laurels.
