IN BRIEF

Detached countryside property in a quiet hamlet location. The house currently has one bedroom but there is the possibility to create a second bedroom on the first floor.

On the ground floor are a spacious, glazed veranda with a tiled floor and views over the garden, a lounge (5.69m x 4.25m) with exposed stone wall, tiled floor, and log burner (to be connected). There is also a fitted kitchen with exposed stone wall, and a stable door leading to the garden; a downstairs bathroom with corner bath and washbasin (1.4m x 2.05m), separate WC, and a laundry room (1.93m x 4.33m). A door from the laundry room provides an access to the large garage (30m2), which has a concrete floor.

On the first floor are a bedroom (4.67m x 5.28m), a second room to renovate (3.79m x 5.28m)...

DESCRIPTION

There is also an outbuilding with large, open plan tiled ground floor, temporary bathroom, and stairs to access the first floor.

The property is located in a quiet hamlet where there are three other properties, but is completely private.

Local amenities can be found a few minutes' drive away in Saint Gilles Pligeaux (bar/tabac/grocery store). The larger medieval town of Quintin, famous for its chateau and weaving history, is less than 15 minutes' drive, and has supermarkets, bars, restaurants, banks, schools, etc.

The medieval town of Guingamp is 20 minutes' drive, and you can access the coast in under 35 minutes.
