

DESCRIPTION

As you enter the property, you are welcomed by a large hallway with an omate staircase on one side and a small mezzanine above. The property is believed to date back to the 18th century. To the left, you'll find the KITCHEN 22.95m2 which boasts a wide range of newly fitted units and a wood-burning stove that can be used both for cooking and heating the room. To the right of the hallway is the spacious LIVING ROOM 40.8m2, with ample space for a dining table and a lounge area. This room also features a log-burning stove at one end.

Continuing from the living room you will find a UTILITY ROOM 8m2 equipped with plumbing for a washing machine, as well as a WC and a shower.

Upstairs, above the main house, there are two double bedrooms (28m2 and 9m2), each with their own newly installed ensuite bathrooms, plus there is a separate WC. Access to the attic is also available from this floor.

In the second part of the house, there are three additional double bedrooms all recently redecorated (19.3m2, 17.6m2 and 30m2), all with newly fitted ensuite bathrooms. These rooms are currently used as Bed & Breakfast accommodations. Guests enter via the most beautiful ornate stone staircase in the garden, leading directly into a large DINING ROOM/SITTING ROOM 30.1m2, with rooms branching off on both sides. A corridor runs along one side of this part of the house and connects with the corridor...
