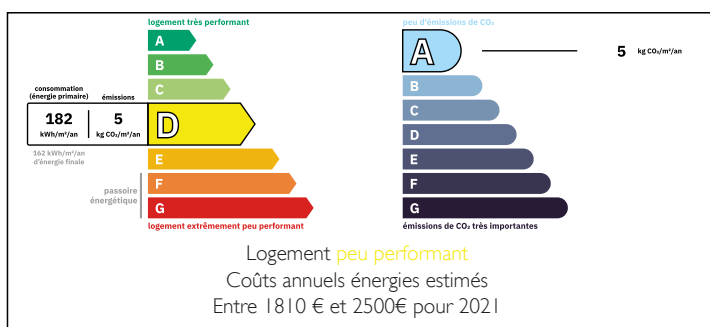

DESCRIPTION

A large entry opens up to offer the house and gîte to one side and large barns to the other. Adequate parking for numerous vehicles, the property, has, in the past, been exploited as an equestrian centre as there are miles of bridle paths directly from the property.

On entering the main house, we are in the main living area. Larger than average, it has exposed stone walls, beams, a stone fireplace with a large wood burner. Behind, the lounge, an office and to the side, a large galley kitchen, a dining room, and a snug with a large window offering the views.

Further along the kitchen, an entrance from the land to the rear of the house, a large family sized bathroom with separate shower, a day room or downstairs bedroom and store room.

On the first floor, an exceptionally large master bedroom with a balcony running along the length, again with those stunning views.

There is also another shower room, and a large open plan bedroom, with access to the second floor, with two further bedrooms.

Outside, the land is mostly on the hillside, with a small woodland, a water source leading down to a pond at the bottom of the land.

There is also a one bedroom gîte attached to the house, with a kitchen, and shower and WC on the ground floor. A lounge on the first floor, with a mezzanine bedroom on the second.
