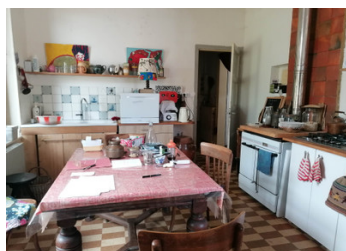

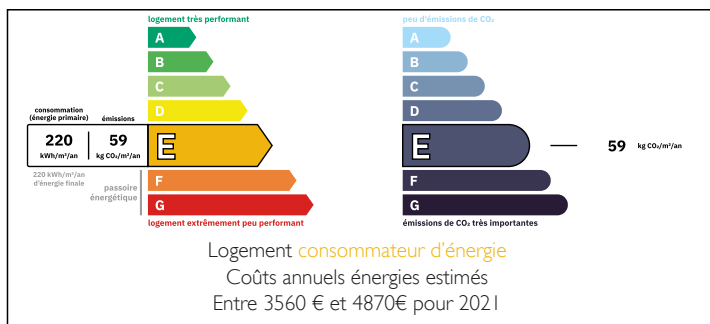
IN BRIEF

Bar-bistro in a great location in the centre of Saint-Gemme, a pretty village in the Brenne Regional Nature Park, much loved by locals, tourists and sports enthusiasts alike. The property is located at a central crossroads of four roads, with the village car park opposite offering plenty of free parking spaces. It comes with permission to use 4 metres of pavement at the front for outdoor tables and chairs.

In recent years, the property has been run as an Association, opening occasionally and offering a programme of music and cultural events in the 60 m² lounge. Notable for the many original features preserved in the bar-bistro, this property offers an excellent opportunity to acquire a bar-bistro with an authentic atmosphere, with spacious accommodation upstairs and a large garden to the rear.

DESCRIPTION

The property for sale comprises the walls and floor and not the business.

The main door from the street opens directly into the bar/bistro which has an original wooden bar and tiled floor as well as double glazing and electric shutters. This light, attractive space currently caters for 20-25 people. The sale includes the wooden bistro tables and chairs as well as metal tables/chairs for outdoor use.. From here a door leads to the 60m2 salon which can accommodate 100 people. Off the bar is a toilet and sink for use by patrons. The kitchen includes appliances and good working spaces and is supplemented by two storage areas with fridges/freezers and plenty of storage space.

On the first floor are four bedrooms including three doubles and one single as well as a shower room.

Outside the kitchen door is a decked verandah with table and chairs. The garden is not currently maintained but includes two outbuildings, a wood shed and a recently acquired bread oven.
