
#### IN BRIEF

### DESCRIPTION

Sitting in the corner of the hamlet, this lovely stone property has a courtyard with two large barns and land to the side and rear, is ideal for grazing. Lots of private off-road parking. The garden and land have been fenced and a hedging planted in the last year. With a covered terrace area leading into the kitchen, (5.4m2), which although small is efficiently fitted with modern units, built-in oven and ceramic hob, tiled walls and floor. Through to the spacious salon, dining room, (29m2), with open stone fireplace with a wood burner fire, tiled flooring, and exposed stone walls with beamed ceiling.

A lovely beech wood staircase leads up to the first floor, and landing, to the left is a modern shower room,(4.30m2), with cubicle shower, wash basin and wc. Built in storage under the eaves and housing the hot water tank. The double bedroom,(21.50m2), has more exposed beams and oak flooring, and two windows making this a nice bright room.

Up another beech staircase to the second floor, and the second double bedroom, (13.75m2), with dual aspect velux windows showing off the beautiful views of the hamlet and countryside beyond. This bedroom has reversible air conditioning.

The house is heated by the wood-burner fire and also has electric heating on all floors. Double glazing throughout including the front and back doors and all windows have shutters.

Outside the barns are in very good condition, all roofs and the zinc gutterings have been replaced. One barn is 100m2 and the second...
