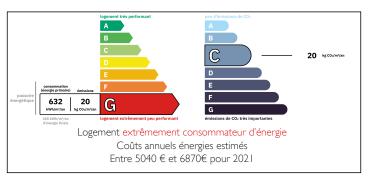

DESCRIPTION

GROUND FLOOR:

Enter via an impressive stone staircase to the welcoming entrance hall.

SALON: ($3.6m \times 4.9m$) an elegant room with high ceilings, original fireplace with wood burner, wood panelling and views over the garden and the countryside beyond. DINING ROOM: ($2.9m \times 3.7m$) with countryside views. KITCHEN: ($4.9m \times 2.7m$) fully fitted kitchen with white units, breakfast bar and garden views. OFFICE: ($2.8m \times 2.8m$)

Staircase to FIRST FLOOR: spacious landing, MASTER BEDROOM: $(4.9 \text{m} \times 3.6 \text{m})$ a beautiful light room with high ceiling and original fireplace - this bedroom has its own stunning ensuite bathroom ($2.8 \text{m} \times 2.8 \text{m}$) with shower, washbasin, WC and a roll-top bath which has been placed to look across the garden. BASEMENT: accessed from the entrance hall, the basement is very large and has 4 separate rooms - great for storage of garden furniture and bikes. The current owners use one of the rooms as a bar and another contains their spa - the possibilities are endless!

GARDEN:

The garden can be accessed from the basement as well as from the rear of the entrance hall. The sloping garden has established trees and there are great views over the surrounding countryside.
