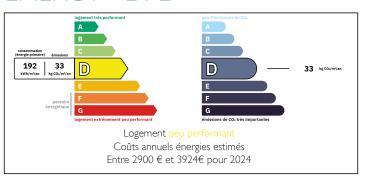

## DESCRIPTION

You approach the house along the long driveway and it is situated centrally within its plot, which is surrounded by fields.

You enter into the generous hallway (16.4m<sup>2</sup>).

To the right is a light sitting room (28M<sup>2</sup>), with original fireplace and log burning stove.

To the left is the newly installed German kitchen/dining room (26M<sup>2</sup>), with central island.

At the end of the hall, a corridor which leads to Bedroom I  $(9M^2)$ ,

the shower room (4.6M<sup>2</sup>), with Italian shower, WC (2.5M<sup>2</sup>) and utility room (6.8M<sup>2</sup>), which houses the oil boiler, fueling the central heating system.

Upstairs, the stairs split and to the right you will find 2 double bedrooms in the eaves ( $11M^2$ ,  $10.5M^2$ ) and a shower room with WC ( $3.M^2$ ).

To the left, there is a spacious landing, leading to the master suite

comprising Bedroom (14.2M²), dressing room (6.4M²) and bathroom (6.7M²)

Outside the kitchen door, there is the decked pool area (pool is  $9M \times 5M$ ) and the garden is mostly lawn with fruits trees and shrubs and is completely fenced.

There is a useful barn of approximately 40M<sup>2</sup>, currently used for storage but it does have potential and another wooden shed.
