IN BRIEF

A magnificent and rare 17th/18th century maison de maitre whose enclosed courtyard has remained virtually unchanged since the cadastre Napoléon plan of 1812. Part of the property with a slate roof in fair condition is perfectly habitable with 3 bedrooms (2 overlook the river) and two bathrooms as well as a kitchen/dining room and a sitting room. The rest of the property with tiled roofs needs restoration and therefore priced accordingly, but it includes a small cottage in the corner of a high walled garden at the rear. This is huge opportunity to acquire a very rare property at an affordable price where one can live in comfort while tackling restoration projects on site.

Ground Floor

Kitchen/dining room, tiled with large fireplace, fitted kitchen units, 2 windows and exit door to the court, and glass doors to the sitting room 33 m²

Sitting room with a parquet floor, fireplace and wood burner, window and French door 25 m² Veranda 10 m²

Washroom with shower washbasin and w/c 3,4 m² Ist bedroom with parquet floor, fireplace and a French door to the courtyard 24 m²

1st floor

2nd bedroom with two windows overlooking the garden at the rear and an ancient hardwood 'Périgordine' floor 27 m²

The two wings either side of the centre are projects for restauration, in some buildings the roof has been restored one side but not the other. The rooms in these areas are all on the ground floor, many have lovely features and period mouldings. Short term measures to stop any further infiltration of humidity (roof patching) would be a necessary 1st step. The property is priced in consideration to these initial projects.

Outside

A raised walled garden at the rear with a cottage opposite (included) that needs restoration, there is a rear exit from the garden to the village down steps and through the wall.

A fabulous, enclosed court which includes all facades and an arched gateway.

The property is in an ancient partially fortified riverside village with a medieval abbey and castle.
