

DESCRIPTION

The living area of approx. 350 m2, with gas heating, is located within the 19th century main building and comprises: on the ground floor: large entrance hall with elm-wood staircase leading to the first floor, dining room with fireplace, large living room with stone fireplace, kitchen with stone bbg fireplace with access to the vaulted stone cellar in the basement and stone staircase leading to the first floor, utility room, boiler room, large bedroom, adjoining shower room and toilet. First floor: large landing, 4 bedrooms, bathroom, dressing room, WC, mezzanine, games room. The adjoining 17th century building comprises a wine storehouse (known as "Le Paradis") with a surface area of approx. 61 m2, topped by an attic of the same size, all of which could be converted into living accommodation. The extension and annexes include 5 outbuildings with a total surface area of approx. 580 m2. There are 2 wells and a Charentais-style house used as offices with a surface area of approx. 300 m2. Totally independent, a 72 m2 garage for 4 vehicles, topped by a mezzanine. Adjoining is a garage for garden equipment and lawnmowers, and a 92 m2 wine storehouse. In the grounds, a pool house with a disused swimming pool and a rare 19th century Victorian greenhouse.
