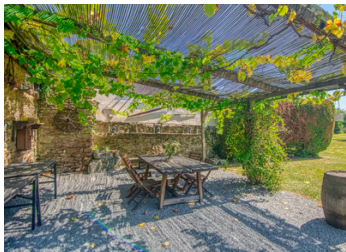

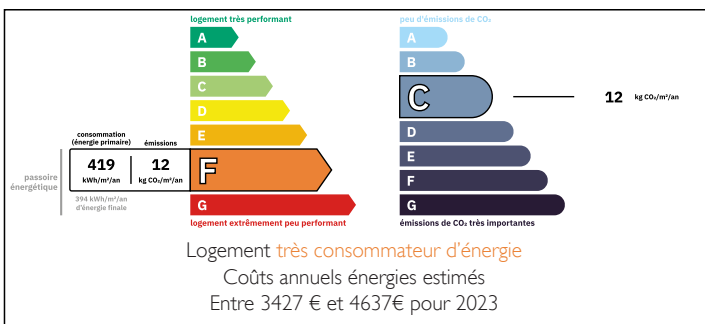

Ground Floor
