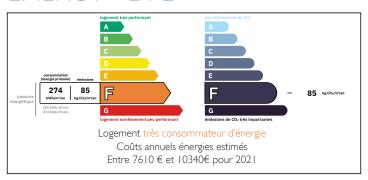
### IN BRIEF

## DESCRIPTION

The drive in to the property is hidden by trees off a quiet lane. The property is a traditional longere but has a modern feel to it. As you enter the front door there is a large cupboard, ideal for all those coats and shoes.

Directly opposite is the kitchen with door to the rear garden. To the left is the lounge/dining area with an impressive open fire and a large, traditional staircase leading to the next floor. Turning left from the front door there are two bright bedrooms, a WC, a bathroom and an additional room that could be an office or bedroom 7.

On the first floor there is a large landing, currently being used as a games area, with a high vaulted ceiling. There are a further four bedrooms, one of which has an en suite shower room. There is also a large store cupboard and a family bathroom.
