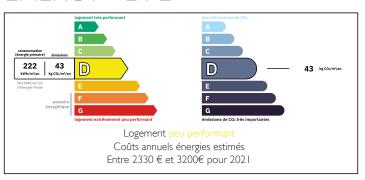




IN BRIEF
