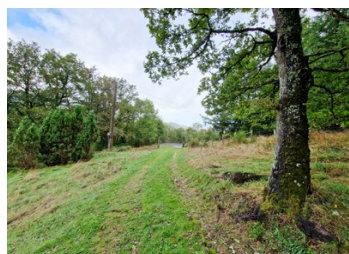


Cosy, stone cottage with countryside views in a peaceful hamlet near the market town of Felletin

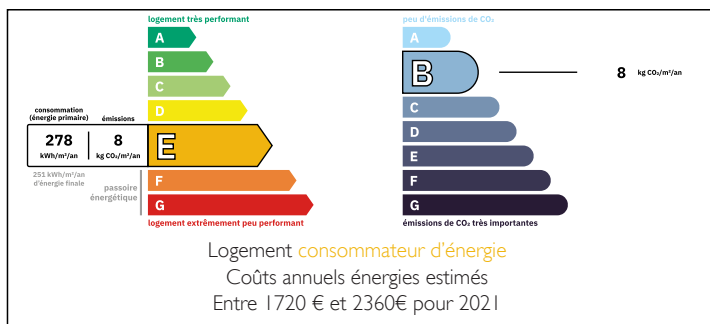

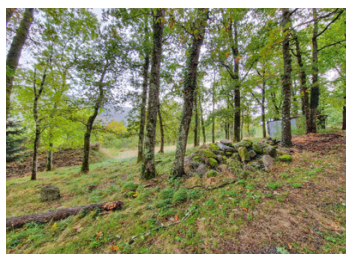
This pretty, stone cottage is situated in a peaceful hamlet between Felletin and Croze. In an elevated position, there are stunning views across open countryside. Built at the beginning of the 18th Century, it retains many original features - a large granite fireplace, exposed beams and a fully functioning bread oven! The hamlet is just 15 minutes away from Felletin with its weekly market, supermarkets, shops, schools, bars and restaurants and half an hour from the beautiful tapestry town of Aubusson with its shops, bars and restaurants, tapestry museum, theatre, cinema, schools, hospital, doctors, vets and swimming pool complex. DESCRIPTION

.GROUND FLOOR: to the left of the entrance door, a spacious LIVING ROOM with insert wood burner with a system installed that also heats other rooms upstairs, entrance to vaulted cellar - perfect for your wine collection!

To the right of the entrance door, a large KITCHEN/DINING ROOM with original beams and large granite fireplace with woodburner. Fitted kitchen with island unit. Access to shower room with WC and also to the attached barn, which is used for wood storage.

FIRST FLOOR: small landing, to the right BEDROOM ONE - a huge room with its own bathroom consisting of balneo bath, WC, washbasin and heated towel rail, to the left of the landing, BEDROOM 2 - another large room with wooden stairs to a third bedroom.

SECOND FLOOR: BEDROOM 3 - this room is enormous! There is room for a bed and a study area but also there is a third bathroom area consisting of a shower, WC and washbasin. There are velux windows with shutters. The roof is insulated in addition to all external walls.

Courtyard garden in front of the house, meadow and woodland behind the house with a woodstore. Access to a country lane at the top. All the land is enclosed.
