

Hidden away at the end of the drive, this delightful property has been beautifully restored to a high standard, whilst maintaining its character and charm. Gorgeous original tiled floors, and double glazed windows throughout, fill the spacious family home with light.

The old Mill forms the main house, with a number of out buildings, including a granny annexe, an enormous barn, and a wood store, in the former bakery with its bread oven intact.

On the ground floor of the Mill there is a very large open plan kitchen,

dining area, and family space, with a wonderful fire place and wood burner.

Through double doors you enter the the main entrance hall, with a WC and stairs to the 1 st floor. On the other side of the hall it leads to a corridor with space for coats and boots, and a utility room and a cave/cellar.

Ahead, and up a few steps, you enter a large bedroom, windows on 2 sides, and a fire place, and a door to the outside. There is a large bathroom and access to the boiler room.

On the first floor you will find an impressive sitting room with vaulted ceiling, a granite fireplace with wood burning stove, and an enormous window with French doors to a balcony, giving onto wonderful views of the stream and fields.
