

DESCRIPTION

This unique 1860 barn, completely renovated in 1992 and with further improvements made to the first floor in 2016, offers a blend of historical charm and modern comfort. Set on a spacious 3000m² plot in a quiet, serene area, the property is perfect for nature lovers and those seeking an authentic, character-filled home.

On the ground floor, the home features a delightful living area with exposed brick and terracotta tiles, complemented by a cozy wood-burning stove and an open-plan kitchen. A charming storeroom adjoins the kitchen, along with a bathroom and a separate toilet.

The upper floor, with solid parquet flooring throughout, boasts a long, bright hallway leading to 4 bedrooms, a study area, a shower room, and another separate toilet.

Modern amenities include central heating via a heat pump, a thermodynamic hot water tank, and double-glazed windows.

Outside, the property features a 67m² tiled east-facing awning, an 18m² west-facing terrace, a carport, and a shed. The large, tree-filled plot offers a swimming pool, the possibility of subdivision, and individual drainage. A school bus service also runs through the street, adding convenience for families.
