

### IN BRIEF

This delightfully restored character town house is located in a thriving ancient bastide with local shops, restaurants and services.

Benefiting from an outdoor terrace with an in-ground pool heated by heat pump and a double garage, this is a rare chance to buy a house in this town with these features.

This comfortable family home has an excellent flow of rooms on the ground floor with a dining entrance hall leading on to the spacious, light and airy kitchen with contemporary fitted units and a utility room adjacent. The large sitting room has two principle zones separated by an imposing feature staircase. A snug area has a wood burning stove and seating area looking on to the pool deck.

On the first floor, there are four double bedrooms, two en-suite and a further family bathroom.

# DESCRIPTION

The front door enters into a large entrance dining room (30sqm) with access to the fitted kitchen (28sqm)/utility room (8sqm) beyond and the sitting room and snug (45sqm).

The kitchen door leads on to a paved south-facing terrace with outdoor dining space and flowerbeds. The in-ground heated swimming pool is a rare find for a townhouse of this kind. Steps lead down to a pedestrian entrance to the road at the back of the house and a double garage with electrically operated door.

From the sitting room, the feature wooden staircase leads up to the first floor with a double bedroom (20sqm and 15sqm) to each side of the landing (6sqm).

A family bathroom (6sqm) has been tastefully restored with a bath, sink, toilet and shower in a classic style.

A short flight of steps leads up to two further double bedrooms (30sqm and 16sqm) both of which benefit from en-suite bathrooms (7.5sqm and 7.5sqm) each with bath, toilet and sink and one of which also has a shower.

The feature stairs continue up to a boarded attic space with Velux window 50sqm). This could easily be transformed into additional bedrooms or hobby space/workshop/studio. A further unboarded attic is accessed through a door.

This house is located in a popular medieval bastide with all the local amenities on the doorstep. A wide range of shops, bars and restaurants make this a popular tourist town with easy access to both the Dordogne and Lot valleys.
