Just 20 minutes to Angouleme and just over an hour to Bordeaux, this is a great house and a must to view.



DESCRIPTION

The original house, now the guests accommodation was the original farmhouse to this extensive property dating back to the 1700's.

There is a wealth of original features in the house and because of its farming history, along with extensive barn areas too.

You approach the house through a huge Charentaise gated arch, a unique feature to this part of the world. There is a large courtyard with access to the rear of the house and the numerous barn areas.

On entering through the impressive arched gateway, to your right is the main house and the very recent and extremely attractive in-ground swimming pool on your left.

An old bread oven stands in the corner of the enclosed courtyard waiting to be brought back to life. Ideal for pizza!

There were a range of small buildings now converted into a a shaded seating area, ideal for outdoor dining and long, warm summer evenings.

This house is quite unusual as it has windows and doors on the north and south facing walls. Normally, windows and doors were never fitted to the cold north face. With the added benefit of double glazing throughout, the property is cooler in summer and cosy during the cooler months.

This gives the whole house a light airy feel.

The back door leads into a the main hall with the sitting room (30m2) off to one side. There is exposed stone wall and a beautiful original open fireplace.
