

### DESCRIPTION

The house comprises as follows;

Enter on the ground floor into the

Kitchen /Lounge /diner - 23m² with wood burning stove and granite fire place. This leads to

Bedroom I-  $13m^2$  with small office space and separate WC to the rear.

The stairs lead to a landing - 9m<sup>2</sup> with office space below a dormer window;-

Bedroom 2 - 15m<sup>2</sup> with dressing room beside and hot water tank within.

Bathroom - 9m<sup>2</sup> containing toilet shower and wash basin - bright and prettily renovated.

Return to the ground floor and outside at the rear on a lower level is a lean to building containing a Bedroom/ games room -  $12m^2$  with sink and toilet separate.

The lean to also houses a wood store and some garden tools and there are french doors leading to the lower garden. The area is mostly laid to lawn but also a large well maintained vegetable plot.

Adjacent to the road is parking for three vehicles.

The property benefits from recently installed mains drainage and optic fibre in the area.
