Located just 15 minutes from Saint Nicolas du Pelem, in the heart of the countryside, this fantastic property was once a French trotter training center and is currently operating as a racing and show jumping horse training facility.

The property spans 3.8 hectares and includes the following:

A Gîte: The only habitable house on the property, featuring one bedroom, a living room, kitchen, and bathroom. The house has been completely renovated and includes an attic space to be developed.

Main House: A large property stripped down to its original walls, ready for renovation. Attached to the back of the house are a few horse boxes.

Stone Barn: Currently housing the horse walking machine and feed storage.

Another Stone Barn: Could be converted into a residential property.

Barn/Boxes: Includes a small paddock area.

Open Shed: Used for hay bales and tractor storage. Storage Shed: For general storage purposes.

Open Stables: With an enclosure in front.

Another Stable Block: Additional stabling for horses. Round pen : A 50-meter lunge ring, previously used as a horse walker.

Arena: A riding arena for training.

500m Gallop Track: Ideal for training racehorses.

Numerous Paddocks: Ample grazing land for horses. The property is supplied with its own bore hole, ensuring a self-sustaining facility.
