Seperate WC

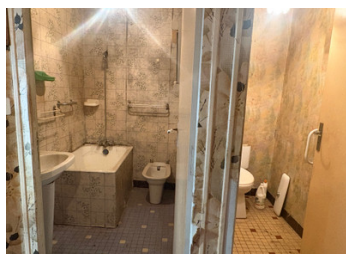
Lounge (16.6m²)
