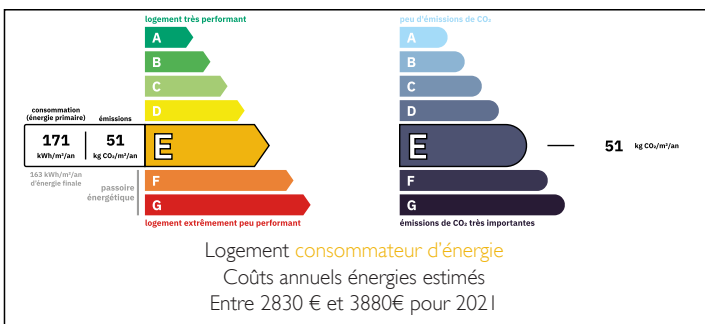

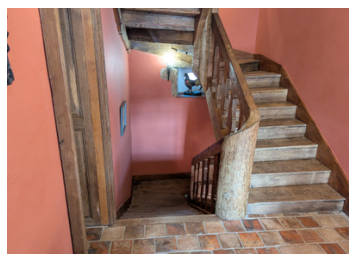

DESCRIPTION

Mentioned as early as the 16th century, this impressive residence was formerly the presbytery of the parish of Briantes and has been inhabited by around thirty parish priests over the years until it was sold by the commune in 1967 when the last priest died and a replacement couldn't be found.

The current owners have undertaken a phenomenal restoration, bringing the presbytery back to its former glory, under strict architectural guidance, which has resulted in the 'Fondation du Patrimoine' label being awarded for the preservation of French heritage.

Entrance is via electric gates, behind which there is ample parking space, and then into the house through a magnificent, original front door. The entrance hall is warm and inviting, and leads, to the left, to the exquisite, triple-aspect sitting room, and to the right to the large dining room with its incredible monumental fireplace. This room opens to the well-equipped kitchen. There is also a toilet on this ground floor.

Upstairs, on the first level, there is a spacious landing, currently used as an office, a master air-conditioned bedroom suite with shower room and dressing room, and a separate annex with two further double bedrooms and a bathroom.

On the second floor, another spacious landing is a flexible space and leads to three further bedrooms – each with its own shower and washbasin – an expansive laundry room with large sink and space for washing machine and dryer, and a separate toilet.
