

The top floor offers a second bedroom (16m²), a bathroom with a small bathtub, and a 14m² terrace with seating and privacy, plus an attic for storage.

Renovated to high standards, the house boasts double glazing, modern heating, and solid wood finishes. Valros offers a quintessential French village

Discover this charming village house located in the center of Valros, overlooking the historic 15th century church. The house has been fully renovated throughout whilst maintaining its original character and charm.

Entering from the church square you are welcomed by a bright lounge of 24m2 with its original beams and stone walls, there is office space and storage which could be converted to a guest WC. Leading through the fully equipped kitchen of 15m2 with its large windows and space to dine.

The original stone staircase takes you to the first floor, here you will find a further space of 19m2 that could be used as an office, snug or the third bedroom , it has large windows overlooking the church facade. You will also find a Shower room with WC and a bedroom (15m2) with original features including beautiful floor tiles and wardrobe space.

From this area stairs take you to the final floor where you will find a bathroom with small bathtub/shower, the second bedroom (16m2) with its original features and the bright terrace of 14m2 (east facing) with built in seating, the terrace benefits from not being overlooked. There is also a small attic, offering additional storage space.

The house has been renovated to a very high standard and features a modern heating system, solid wood doors and fixtures and double glazing. Ready to move in, there is no work to undertake.
