




## IN BRIEF

## DESCRIPTION

#### Lower Ground floor:

A driveway leads to a parking area and a front door opening into the kitchen and dining room. Beyond the kitchen is a large sitting room which could double as a study or 4th bedroom. Doors opening onto the terrace.

#### Stairs up to the Ground floor:

Turn left at the top of the stairs to access two of the bedrooms and a bathroom with bathtub and shower over bath + WC. There is also a door to the exterior at this level, which leads onto a series of stone steps going down to the garden.

Turn right at the top of the stairs and you enter the stunning living room with double height ceilings and exposed beams and stone walls. There is a recently installed powerful woodburner in this room. Double doors and another large window flood the room with light.

#### Stairs to Top floor:

A narrow set of stairs leads from the living room to a mezzanine study area or snug, which in turn leads to the main bedroom and adjoining bathroom. Please note: the fittings for this bathroom are in place but haven't yet been fitted.

Heating: Gas-fired central heating (the tank is tucked away in the garden). Woodburner in the main living room.

Insulation: Many of the windows are double glazed but some of the original windows have been retained to maintain the character of the building. Drainage: A septic tank has been installed which conforms to...
