Old charming stone house build into the rempart walls of the old village.


Passing through the front door entrance, from a small cobbled outside passage, there is an entrance hall with stairway and guest toilet and washbasin.

The garage and the house are separated by a narrow outside passage which has a small room at the end, with plumbing for a washing machine.

The garage roof could be removed, with the potential to create a marvellous roof terrace with breathtaking views, on the first floor of the garage building. The views from the windows of the 2 front bedrooms, extend over the rooves of the village towards the vineyards and the Pyrenées Mountains. La Livinière is 10km from the Canal du Midi and 34 km from Carcassonne, 35 km from Narbonne, 50 km from Béziers. It is 60 minutes from the sea and just under 90 minutes from Spain.
