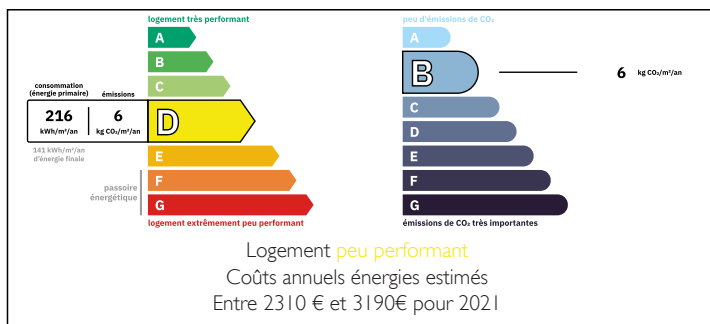

DESCRIPTION

In the centre of the charming little village of Gaja-la-Selve this former boulangerie is still at the heart of the community. There are two entrances into either the downstairs lounge and cinema room or the main living area above. The cinema room has been created next to the bread oven and alongside the lounge area it provides a perfect spot to relax with a blockbuster on a winter's evening. There is a wood-burner to complement the electric heating that keeps the property nice and cosy. The main living area has a corner kitchen as well as plenty of space for dining or curling up with a good book. Best of all you have access out onto the terrace, with a covered kitchen area, and views over the village and countryside beyond. This is the ideal place to enjoy warm spring and summer evenings with a glass of wine or the first morning glow of the sunrise with a coffee.

On the central floor there is a family bathroom, separate toilet and a spacious bedroom. The staircase leads to two further bedrooms on the top floor. One is a good-sized double room, and the other is currently used as a dormitory style room for children with space for 3 or 4 beds and storage space under the eaves. There is also a shower room with a toilet on this floor.
