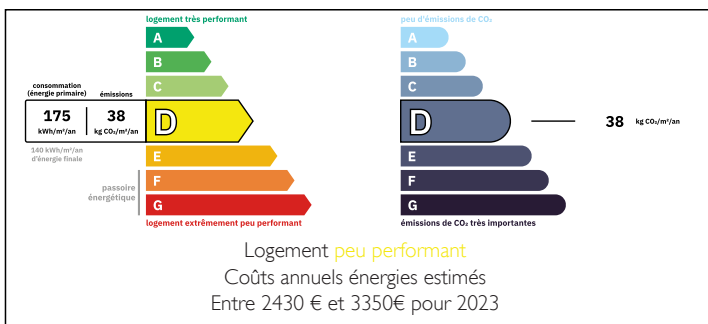


Lovely luminous semi-detached four-bedroom stone longère with terrace and garden, near Loudéac.

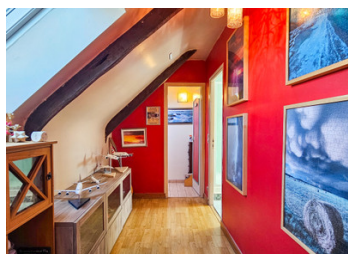
